

ELIGIBILITY FOR VINYL COUNCIL OF AUSTRALIA MEMBERSHIP

SPONSORSHIP

A person is not eligible for membership of Vinyl Council of Australia unless that person is sponsored by another **Ordinary Member** or a **Director**.

ORDINARY MEMBERSHIP

A person is eligible to be an **Ordinary Member** of Vinyl Council of Australia if they are:

- (a) willing to support the objectives of Vinyl Council of Australia; and
- (b) a corporation whose business includes any of the following:
 - PVC resin manufacturer;
 - PVC resin converter;
 - Merchant PVC compounder;
 - PVC product recycler;
 - Major raw material supplier for PVC industry;
 - Major service provider to PVC industry;
 - Merchant PVC resin and compound importer;
 - Importer of intermediate or finished PVC goods;
 - Other industry sectors as approved by Vinyl Council of Australia in general meeting.

PVC STEWARDSHIP PROGRAM MEMBERSHIP

A person is only eligible to be a **PVC Stewardship Program Member** if that person is a corporation and is:

- (a) willing to support the objectives of Vinyl Council of Australia; and
- (b) a signatory to the Australian PVC Stewardship Program.

A **PVC Stewardship Program Member** has no rights and privileges of membership (including the right to vote at any general meeting) except:

- (a) the right to receive any services or benefits from Vinyl Council of Australia that the Board determines (in its absolute discretion but in good faith) are directly related to the management of the Australian PVC Stewardship Program, and
- (b) to receive notices of and to attend and be heard at any general meeting.

ALLIANCE MEMBERSHIP

A person is eligible to be an **Alliance Member** if that person is an individual (and not a corporation):

- (a) willing to support the objectives of Vinyl Council of Australia; and
- (b) works within or consults to an industry sector (including by way of example architecture, design, engineering) and that individual wishes to remain informed of news and events in the Australian PVC industry.

A person is not eligible to be an **Alliance Member** if that person is employed by an **Ordinary Member** or the person's employer would otherwise qualify to be an **Ordinary Member** (see above).

An **Alliance Member** has no rights and privileges of membership (including the right to vote at any general meeting) except:

- (a) the right to receive any services or benefits from Vinyl Council of Australia that the Board determines (in its absolute discretion but in good faith) are to be made available to Alliance Members; and
- (b) to receive notices of and to attend and be heard at any general meeting.

AFFILIATE MEMBERSHIP

A person is eligible to be an **Affiliate Member** if that person is a corporation and is:

- (a) willing to support the objectives of Vinyl Council of Australia; and
- (b) a company engaged in the PVC industry in activities such as fabrication, installation, and re-selling of PVC materials.

An **Affiliate Member** has no rights and privileges of membership (including the right to vote at any general meeting) except:

- (a) the right to receive any services or benefits from Vinyl Council of Australia that the Board determines (in its absolute discretion but in good faith) are to be made available to **Affiliate Members**; and
- (b) to receive notices of and to attend and be heard at any general meeting.

Where one or more **Affiliate Members** have an association with an **Ordinary Member**, Vinyl Council of Australia and the **Ordinary Member** may agree to confer on the **Affiliate Member(s)** the right to receive specified services or benefits from Vinyl Council of Australia that the Board determines (in its absolute discretion but in good faith) are to be made available, such that these rights so conferred:

- (a) do not limit the rights of **Ordinary Members** in any way;
- (b) are cancelled immediately if the:
 - (i) **Ordinary Member** associated with the **Affiliate Member** ceases to be a member of Vinyl Council of Australia; or
 - (ii) the **Ordinary Member** notifies Vinyl Council of Australia that the **Affiliate Member** ceases to be associated with the **Ordinary Member**;
- (c) are subject to Vinyl Council of Australia adhering to any written notification from the **Affiliate Member** withdrawing the consent of the **Affiliate Member** that its personal information retained by the **Ordinary Member** be shared with Vinyl Council of Australia;
- (d) may be cancelled or varied at any time by the Board (in its absolute discretion but in good faith) or by the **Ordinary Members** at a general meeting;
- (e) do not confer any rights and privileges to the **Affiliate Member**, including but not limited to the rights to vote at any general meeting.

ASSOCIATION MEMBERSHIP

Vinyl Council of Australia and **Ordinary Members** may from time to time agree to confer on one or more members of **Ordinary Members** (in this and the following rule "**Association Members**") the right to receive specified services or benefits from Vinyl Council of Australia that the Board determines (in its absolute discretion but in good faith) are to be made available to **Association Members**.

The rights conferred on **Association Members**:

- (a) do not limit the rights of **Ordinary Members** in any way;
- (b) are cancelled immediately if the:
 - (i) **Ordinary Member** associated with the **Association Member** ceases to be a member of Vinyl Council of Australia; or
 - (ii) the **Ordinary Member** notifies Vinyl Council of Australia that the **Association Member** ceases to be a member of the **Ordinary Member**.
- (c) are subject to Vinyl Council of Australia adhering to any written notification from the **Association Member** withdrawing the consent of the **Association Member** that its personal information retained by the **Ordinary Member** be shared with Vinyl Council of Australia;
- (d) may be cancelled or varied at any time by the Board (in its absolute discretion but in good faith) or by the **Ordinary Members** at a general meeting;
- (e) do not confer any rights and privileges to the **Association Member**, including but not limited to the rights to vote at and to attend and be heard at any general meeting.
